

## **Camp St. Charles Family Camping Weekend Community Agreement**

We are very excited to welcome guests to enjoy some precious family time at CSC this summer. In light of the unique circumstances of the coronavirus pandemic, each family will need to review and agree to the following expectations in order to participate. Please discuss these expectations with the members of your family -- each guest will be required to have a signed Covid-19 waiver to attend and participate.

### **Community Expectations**

1. In order to reduce the risk of a COVID-19 exposure at Camp St. Charles, Each guest is encouraged to limit exposure to non-family members, wear masks when physical distancing is difficult, and practice good hand hygiene during the fourteen (14) days prior to attendance. Guests are encouraged to monitor for fever, cough, body aches, shortness of breath, change in taste/smell, headache prior to attendance. Families should not attend when experiencing new or worsening COVID-19 symptoms or following a recent exposure to a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19.
2. Upon arrival at camp, each guest will be screened for temperature and asked about symptoms and/or any known exposure to COVID-19. Guests with a fever of 100.4°F will not be permitted to enter. Family Camping Weekend fees are non-refundable.
3. Quiet hours will begin at 10pm.
4. Alcohol, firearms, fireworks, pets and illegal drugs are not permitted at Camp St. Charles.
5. Guests should not enter cabins other than their assigned cabin.
6. Each family group will use the provided sports equipment and lifejackets issued for the weekend. All items will be sanitized in between events. Families are asked to avoid sharing equipment.
7. Each guest is encouraged to wash hands frequently. Hand washing stations and hand sanitizer will be provided.
8. Many of our scheduled activities will be held outdoors and guests may opt to wear a mask. For some indoor activities, guests will be required to wear masks, for example, when entering the mess hall to your family's assigned table and during arts and crafts activities when physical distancing is not possible. If inclement weather requires us to move other events indoors, we will also ask guests to wear a mask. Guests will be asked to wear masks in some situations to protect other guests and our staff members.
9. Each family is asked to practice physical distancing from other guests and staff members and also assist children with physical distancing.

Due to the unique nature of family camping weekends and the limited number of guests, family camping weekend fees are non-refundable.
